Re: Four Charges Filed in Shooting of Provo Officers

David O. Leavitt, Utah County Attorney filed three charges of Attempted Criminal Homicide, Aggravated Murder, and one charge of Felony Discharge of a Firearm against Keith Justin Taylor of Provo in the alleged February 25, 2021 shooting incident with Provo Police.

Charges state that the victims of the shooting are law enforcement officers and Mr. Taylor intentionally or knowingly attempted to kill the officers responding to a call at the accused's home.

The probable cause statement is included with this statement and provides detail to the sequence of events.

Because the incident involved an officer discharging his weapon, that matter is still under investigation by the Utah County Officer Involved Critical Incident Team. Upon completion of that investigation, the matter will be reviewed by David Leavitt, Utah County Attorney.

The defendant was ordered held without bail.

As is guaranteed by the United States Constitution, all individuals accused of a crime are presumed innocent until proven guilty in a court of law.
